ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

HARVEY ERLICH - Harvey first appeared on Kentwood's stage in STEAMBATH and then in TWELVE ANGRY MEN. His acting career started many years ago in Israel where he appeared in several English language productions. Today he spends much of his time entertaining children in libraries and in Childrens' Hospital. He has also appeared in a TV cable service for children. BAREFOOT IN THE PARK is Harvey's full length directorial debut.

ABOUT THE PRODUCER.....

HARRIET PRICE - Since joining Kentwood Players in 1981, Harriet has been a very active member. She produced THE CHILDREN'S HOUR and BUS STOP. Harriet is best known for her work as our Properties Procurer, finding whatever is needed, large or small, familiar or rare. When she is not prop-hunting, Harriet is working in video, HBO and feature film.

ABOUT THE CAST (alphabetical order).....

JONATHAN COOGAN (Telephone Repairman) - For the past year, Jonathan has been training at the Lee Strasberg Theatre Institute and at the Tracy Roberts Actors Studio. He appeared in sweet charity, plus concerts at CSUN, TV commercials and televised improvisations.

ALICE ELDRIDGE (Mrs. Banks, Corie's Mother) - A 16 year KP member, Alice was last seen in SEE HOW THEY RUN. She has kept busy appearing in SUPPORTING CAST, DON'T DRINK THE WATER and ANGEL STREET. She received Best Actress and Best Supporting Actress awards for her roles in GUYS AND DOLLS, GINGERBREAD LADY and NUTS. Sweet Charity, Last of The Red Hot Lovers, Murder at Howard Johnson's and Bad Habits are just a few of Alice's other acting credits.

JEFF KEANE (Paul Bratter) - Jeff graduated from the University of Southern California with a BFA in Drama in 1980. He has a wide range of experience having appeared in a variety of shows including Black Comedy, Equus, Division Street, Lion in Winter, A Midsummer Night's Dream and Shadow Box. This is Jeff's second appearance on the Kentwood stage. His first being in the role of Clifford Anderson in DEATHTRAP.

CHARLES REYNOLDS (Victor Velasco) - Chuck's first role at Kentwood was in MY THREE ANGELS in 1960. His most recent role was in VERONICA'S ROOM. He directed SUPPORTING CAST, MY THREE ANGELS and A TALENT FOR MURDER. Chuck's favorite acting role is George in WHO'S AFRAID OF VIRGINIA WOOLF? Other important roles for Chuck include TWELVE ANGRY MEN, ANDERSONVILLE TRIAL, THE TENDER TRAP and ALL THE KING'S MEN. Chuck has received numerous awards for acting, directing and set design.

ABBOTT ROSENBERG (Delivery Man) - Abbott is a long-time member of Kentwood Players, joining the theatre group in 1953. He has appeared in THE TIME OF YOUR LIFE, THREE MEN ON A HORSE, THE MALE ANIMAL, THE SHRIKE and THE WIZARD OF OZ. For the WIZARD OF OZ, Abbott wrote a completely new score, words and music. He has also directed musicals and dramas both in Northern and Southern California. At present he is touring Southern California with a stand-up comedy/song act.

MELINDA WILSON (Corie Bratter) - This is Melinda's first appearance with Kentwood Players. She is a Theatre Arts graduate from California State University Long Beach. Some of Melinda's past college and community theatre roles have been in Shadow Box, A Flea in Her Ear, Charlie's Aunt, The Real Inspector Hound and Grease.
