ABOUT THE DIRECTOR - DORIS MAZEROV

Doris, a producer, director and actress, is a 37 year member of Kentwood Players and has also served on the Board of Directors, having been Vice-President for four years. Her Masque Awards include best producer for TAMING OF THE SHREW and AUNTIE MAME, Best Director for NUTS and MAN OF LA MANCHA, Best Actress (Blanche Du Bois) in STREETCAR NAMED DESIRE in 1957 and for the 84 year old grandmother in CLOSE TIES in 1987. Also in 1987, BRIGHTON BEACH MEMOIRS, the first autobiographical play of the Neil Simon Trilogy was directed by Mrs. Mazerov.

ABOUT THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR - TIM BOECK

Mild mannered accountant by day, schizoid assistant director by night. His multiple Kentwood personalities have included stage manager and assorted back stage and technical "stuff". In addition to his unseen backstage work he has been seen on stage in SHE LOVES ME, ANYTHING GOES and as the Klansman Jimmy Bob Bueford in the FOREIGNER.

ABOUT THE PRODUCER - JENNY ASH

BROADWAY BOUND marks Jenny's third play as producer, having also produced BRIGHTON BEACH MEMOIRS and PACK OF LIES at KP. An active member for more than ten years, Jenny has worked as an actress, on stage crews, and as a light and sound operator on countless productions. She serves on the Board of Directors at Kentwood as the Production Chairperson. In her spare time, Jenny teaches first grade.

JON BERNSTEIN - Stanley

Mel has been a Kentwood Member over 30 years. He has appeared in more than 25 productions and has won awards for Best Actor as

GAIL BERNARDI - Blanche

Gail is a native of Pennsylvania where she studied acting at Carnegie Mellon's Drama Department. Productions in which she has appeared include both comedy and drama roles as varied as Emma Kalovortz in "Enter Laughing" to Lady Macbeth in "Macbeth". Her TV credits include "Silver Spoons", "General Hospital" and "Hail to the Chief". Gail was Veta Louise in our production of HARVEY and last appeared at Kentwood as Trudy Heyman in SOCIAL SECURITY.

GARY RUBENSTEIN - Eugene

This is Gary's first show since moving to LA. His last role was Stanley in "Brighton Beach Memoirs." He now hopes to do "Biloxi Blues" to finish the trilogy. Other credits include "Play It Again Sam" and "Look Homeward Angel" among others.
